Granite Seed Company's Meadow Lawn Mix provides a low-cost, low-water and low-maintenance lawn alternative for those who want to reduce the time and money spent mowing, fertilizing and watering thirsty, work intensive lawns. This blend of low-growing grasses is shade tolerant, requires less frequent watering than traditional bluegrass or ryegrass lawns and thrives in low-fertility soils and other problem areas of your yard. It requires no fertilizer or fungicide.

Meadow Lawn is easy to maintain. Keep a manicured look by mowing once a month, or leave it un-mowed to create a rugged, naturalized appearance. When infrequently mowed it can prevent weeds from establishing and will keep the soil moist, leaving more water for trees and garden plants during the dry summer months. At the very least, mow once a year to allow sunlight to warm the soil and stimulate new growth. Meadow Lawn Mix Species:

- Streambank wheatgrass
- Crested wheatgrass
- Sheep fescue

For a lawn, apply at 8-10 lbs per 1,000 ft² using a broadcast or drop spreader. Because of the water-wise nature of Meadow Lawn, it is slower to establish and than Kentucky bluegrass lawns. During the first growing season irrigate similar to a traditional lawn. In subsequent years, the amount and frequency of irrigation can be reduced.

For a naturalistic meadow, apply at 25 lbs per acre. You can also add wildflowers to benefit pollinators!
