
Shady Lawn Blend





Shady Lawn Turf Mix is perfect for areas with full or heavy shade. This mix of creeping red fescue and chewing fescue thrives in low light where other turfgrasses will struggle. Our **Shady Lawn Turf Mix** is TWCA qualified, so it requires much less water than other fine fescues even in direct sunlight. These fine fescues form a dense sod with an incredibly soft, feather-like texture that can grow in less fertile soil than Kentucky bluegrass and perennial ryegrass can tolerate. The Shady Lawn Turf Mix can also be blended with Sheep and Hard fescues to create a versatile low-maintenance fine fescue turf. Together, these cool-season grasses can tolerate temperature extremes, require less water than traditional home lawns, and can be used to create a meadow-like landscape that can be grown on hillsides and other difficult to maintain areas.

Pro Tip: Keep the soil damp, but not soggy, for the first 30 days after planting. Consider setting your irrigation system to water for periods of 3 to 5 minutes, several times per day until your new lawn is at least 4 inches tall. After the second mowing you can start cutting back the watering cycles to 15 minutes 2-3 times per week as needed.
